Sugar Pine Point State Park 9 miles south of Tahoe City off Hwy 89. ¼ mile, ½ mile & 2 mile interpretive forest & lakeside loop trails

North Tahoe Regional Park-Tahoe Vista off Hwy 28 on National Avenue, ¾ mile interpretive loop through the forest

Tahoe Meadows- Mt. Rose Hwy 431 above Incline Village. 1.3 mile loop that wanders thru lush alpine meadows & crosses streams

Spooner Lake Loop-11 miles south of Incline Village off Hwy 28. Loop is 2 miles around Spooner Lake, wildlife viewing area

Scenic Drives, Museums and Historic Tours

72 Mile Lake Tahoe Scenic Drive-A pleasant 72-mile mountain drive around the lake with breath-taking views and historical points of interest

Gatekeeper's Cabin-Home of the North Lake Tahoe Historic Society Museum & Marion Steinbach Native American Basket Collection, located next to the Truckee River outlet dam in Tahoe City. Open daily 10-4 pm 530.583.1762

Tahoe Maritime Museum-1 miles south of Tahoe City. Step back to the time when grand steamships and gleaming wood boats plied the waters of the lake. Closed Wednesdays, Open 10 am to 5 pm. 530.525.9253

Fanny Bridge-South of the intersection of Highways 89 & 28, at the light in Tahoe City. People bending over the rail of the bridge to watch trout frolic below Lake Tahoe's only outlet, the Truckee River, gives the bridge its name

Donner Memorial State Park & Museum-Highway 80, at the East end of Donner Lake in Truckee. Featuring information about the Donner Party, the history of Truckee & the building of the trans-continental railroad over the Sierras. Open daily 9 am-4 pm 530.582.7894

Hellman-Ehrman Mansion, Sugar Pine Point State Park-Located off Highway 89 nine miles south of Tahoe City on the West Shore. Explore 2 family friendly self-guided Nature Trails wandering through the forest and lake. Tour the historic Pine Lodge. Built in 1903 this stunning estate exemplifies Tahoe's Golden Age. Daily tours May 25-Sept 30 from 10:30 am-3:30 pm

Vikingsholm Castle-Emerald Bay, one of the most photographed sites in the world. Located 21 miles south of Tahoe City on Hwy 89. 1 mile walk down to the shoreline of the bay. This authentic 38-room reproduction of a Scandinavian castle was built in 1929 as a summer vacation home. Daily tours May 25-Sept 30 from 10:30 am-4:30 pm
