



North Lake Tahoe Winter Activities

Scenic Drives and Museums

72 Mile Lake Tahoe Scenic Drive (weather permitting) A pleasant 72-mile mountain drive around the lake affords breath-taking views, fascinating side trips and historical points of interest.

Sugar Pine Point State Park Explore 18.7 kilometers of groomed Nature Trails through the forest and along the lake. This is a great way to take in views of the lake and experience historic trails of the 1960's Olympics. A great lakefront snowshoe trail is free with parking at the California State Park.

Gatekeeper's Cabin Home of the North Lake Tahoe Historic Society museum & Marion Steinbach Native American basket collection, the Gatekeeper's cabin is located adjacent to the Truckee River outlet dam in Tahoe City. Open Wed-Sunday 10 am to 4 pm. 530.583.1762. Fee required

Tahoe Maritime Museum 2 locations: Homewood and a new location just minutes from Tahoe City at the Tahoe Tree Company. This museum gives insight into Lake Tahoe's rich maritime history. Step back to the time when grand steamships and gleaming wood boats plied the waters of the lake. Open Saturdays in Homewood and Fridays-Sundays in Tahoe City 530.525.9253. Fee required

Fanny Bridge Just south of the intersection of Highways 89 & 28, at the traffic light in Tahoe City. In summer people bending over the rail of the bridge to watch trout frolic below Lake Tahoe's only outlet, the Truckee River, gives the bridge its name.

Museum of Sierra Ski History and 1960 Winter Olympics Located on the second floor of the Boatworks Mall in Tahoe City. See the evolution of skiing from longboards to modern alpine skis and explore the largest collection of 1960 Winter Olympics artifacts. There is a new Daron Rahlves and Julia Mancuso Olympic Display. Open daily 10 am to 4 pm. Donation suggested

Museum of 1960 Winter Olympics Located at Squaw Valley's High Camp. 1960 Winter Olympic Memorabilia. Museum accessed by Aerial tram. Open daily at 11am or as conditions permit.
